- Associate or institutional member in good standing for a minimum of 10 consecutive years
- Reached the age of 65 or retired
- Rendered outstanding meritorious service to the medical imaging profession
- Accumulate a minimum of 100 points on the attached evaluation guide.

To be considered for ACERT Life Membership, candidates may nominate themselves or be nominated by other current members. A completed application, updated CV, and supporting documentation of service, if needed, must be submitted by June 1 for evaluation by the BOD.

Bestowment of this honor is subject to board approval. The BOD will score candidates using the attached evaluation guide. The candidate must accumulate a minimum of 100 points, and the Board must unanimously vote to elevate the individual to Life Member. Nomination and accumulation of points does not guarantee life membership and this honor is not necessarily given annually.
