ACERT Outstanding Educator

Revised March 2023

Submission Deadline: June 1

In 1980, the ACERT Outstanding Educator Award was established to honor those educators who have made innovative and outstanding contributions to the radiologic science profession.

Candidates being nominated for Outstanding Educator must meet the following minimum eligibility criteria:

- ACERT associate or institutional member in good standing
- Minimum of five (5) years of teaching experience in the field of radiologic sciences in either a didactic or clinical setting
- Evidence of publication, research, or other scholarly activities where contributions have provided new direction and change and continue to positively influence the profession
- Participation in ACERT and other professional organizations

To be considered for ACERT Outstanding Educator, candidates may nominate themselves or be nominated by other current members. A completed application, updated CV, and supporting documentation of service, if needed, must be submitted by June 1 for evaluation by the BOD.

As part of the application, an Impact Statement must be submitted by someone who has been directly impacted or can attest to the integrity of the impact made by the educator. The formal statement should be written by a current/former student, colleague, or a respected academic leader who works/has worked directly with the nominee. The Impact Statement may be written by the nominator if they qualify, or may be solicited by others that meet the requirements. More than one Impact Statement may be submitted.

Bestowment of this honor is subject to board approval. The BOD must unanimously vote to award the Outstanding Educator Award and it is not necessarily given annually.
